Program Layout

EVENTS: September 2016 - June 2017, events are mandatory for participants.

- ® Kickoff Event: Leadership Retreat, overnight

Program Tuition

- ® Tuition for FY 2016/17 is \$2,750.00. Tuition covers all program costs including a mandatory retreat, meals for program days, materials, Leadership shirts, and speaker costs.
- ® Full payment is due prior to the Leadership Retreat in September.
- ® A limited number of scholarships are available. Contact the program director with questions.
- ® Additional costs may include parking fees for some of the Curriculum/Program Days.
- ® Program participation includes lifetime individual membership in the Greater Albuquerque Chamber of Commerce.
